Well done children (and families!). All the teachers have been delighted with your effort and commitment to your home learning – keep it up!

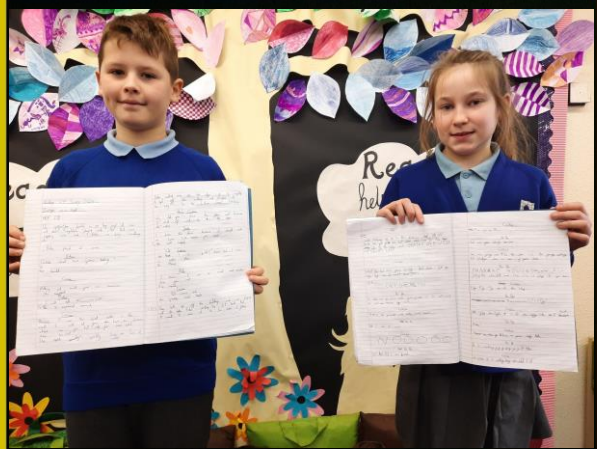
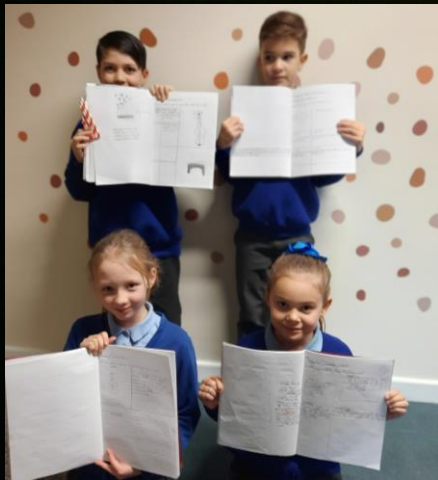
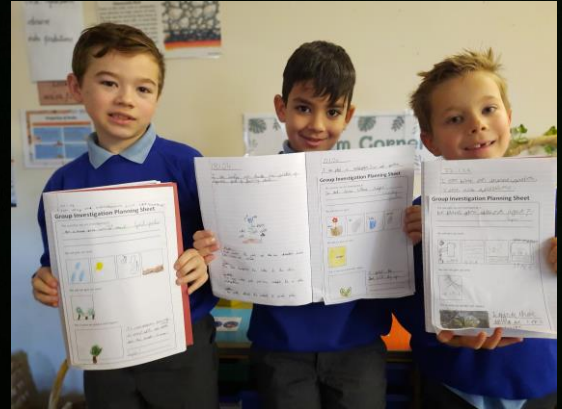
## **Are you looking for employment on a Monday and Friday?**

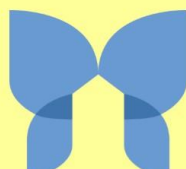
Tea, coffee & cakes will be available in the Village Hall after the event together with a raffle.
