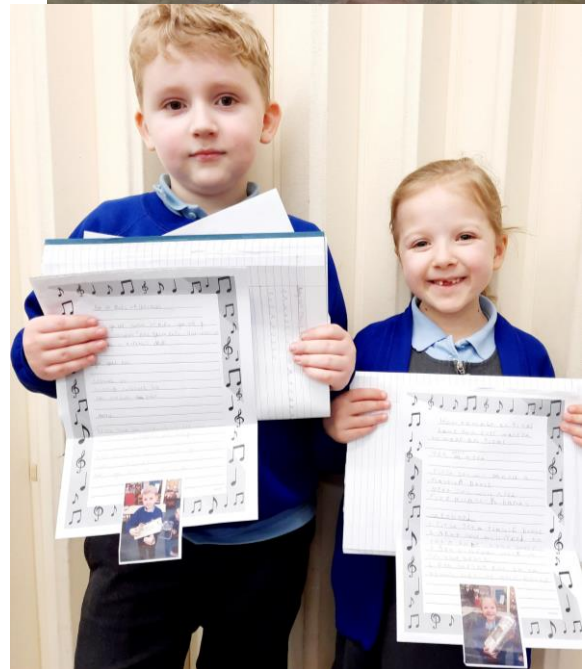
PTA Mothers' Day / Special Person Sale
