A big thank to our volunteers, Judy, Philippa and Kay for giving up your time each week to support reading and our library. Your time is

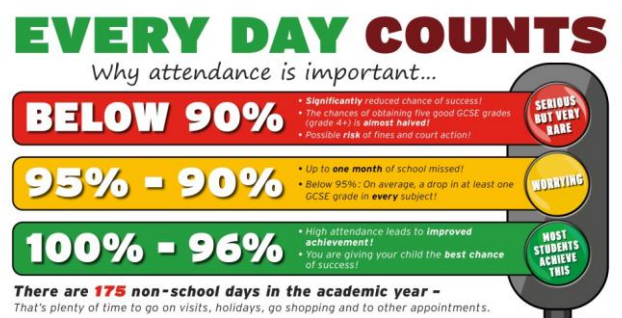
so valuable to us and the children enjoy the time they read with you.
