**School Meal Charges:** As your children will be aware, our meals are all freshly prepared each day here at the school. We haven't increased the cost of our meals for many years, unfortunately due to the rise in costs to us when we return on 4<sup>th</sup> January 2022, the cost of a school meal per day will increase to £2.25. All children in Reception & KS1 are entitled to a government funded free meal, however if you are in receipt of certain benefits we can apply for some funding for the school. If your child/children are in KS2 and you are in receipt of certain benefits or on a low income you may be entitled to Free School Meals. To check it takes just a couple of minutes and you can either call or pop into the school office.
