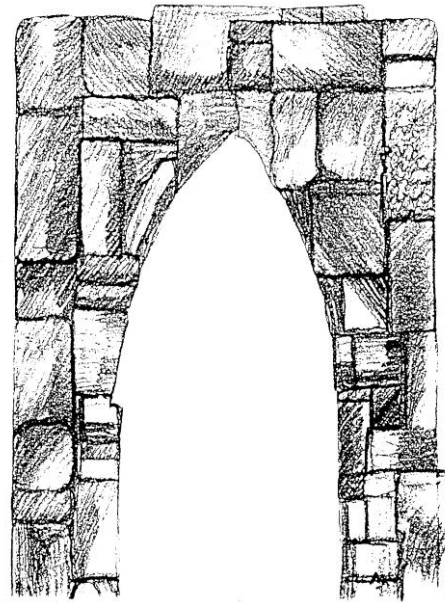


# PRIORY PRIMARY SCHOOL-NEWSLETTER
