School Clubs

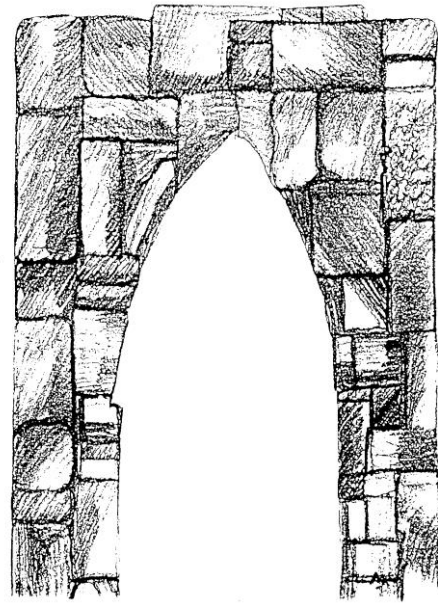
Teacher led after school clubs will begin on Thursday 22nd September.
