# Timings of the school day

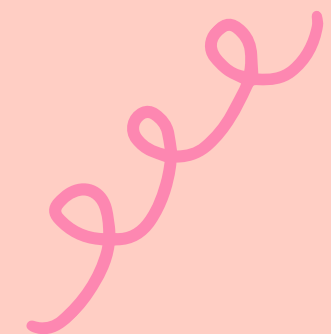
The gates will open at 8:30.  
The bell will be rung at 8:40.

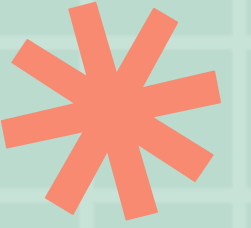
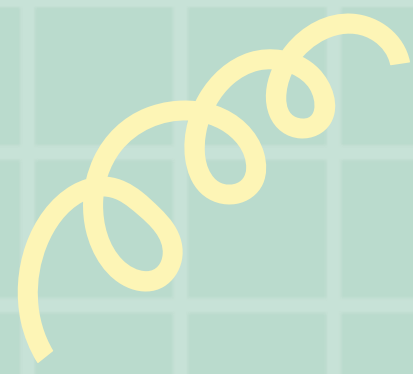
At 8.40 all children should be lined up on playground.

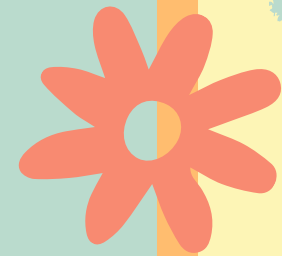
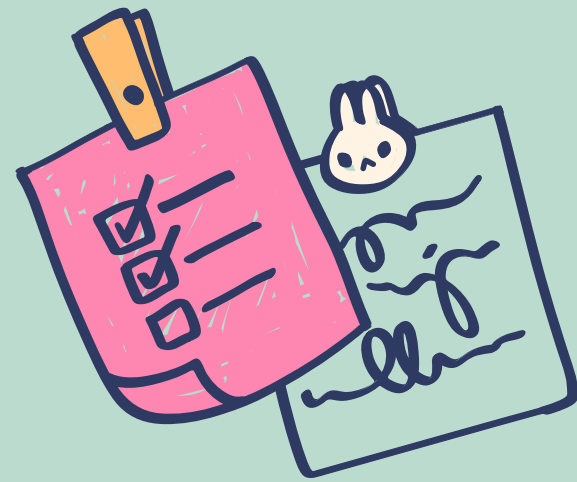
All pupils will be expected to read at least 3 times a week and have this recorded in their reading diaries. If there is no evidence of reading at home the book bag book won't be changed.
